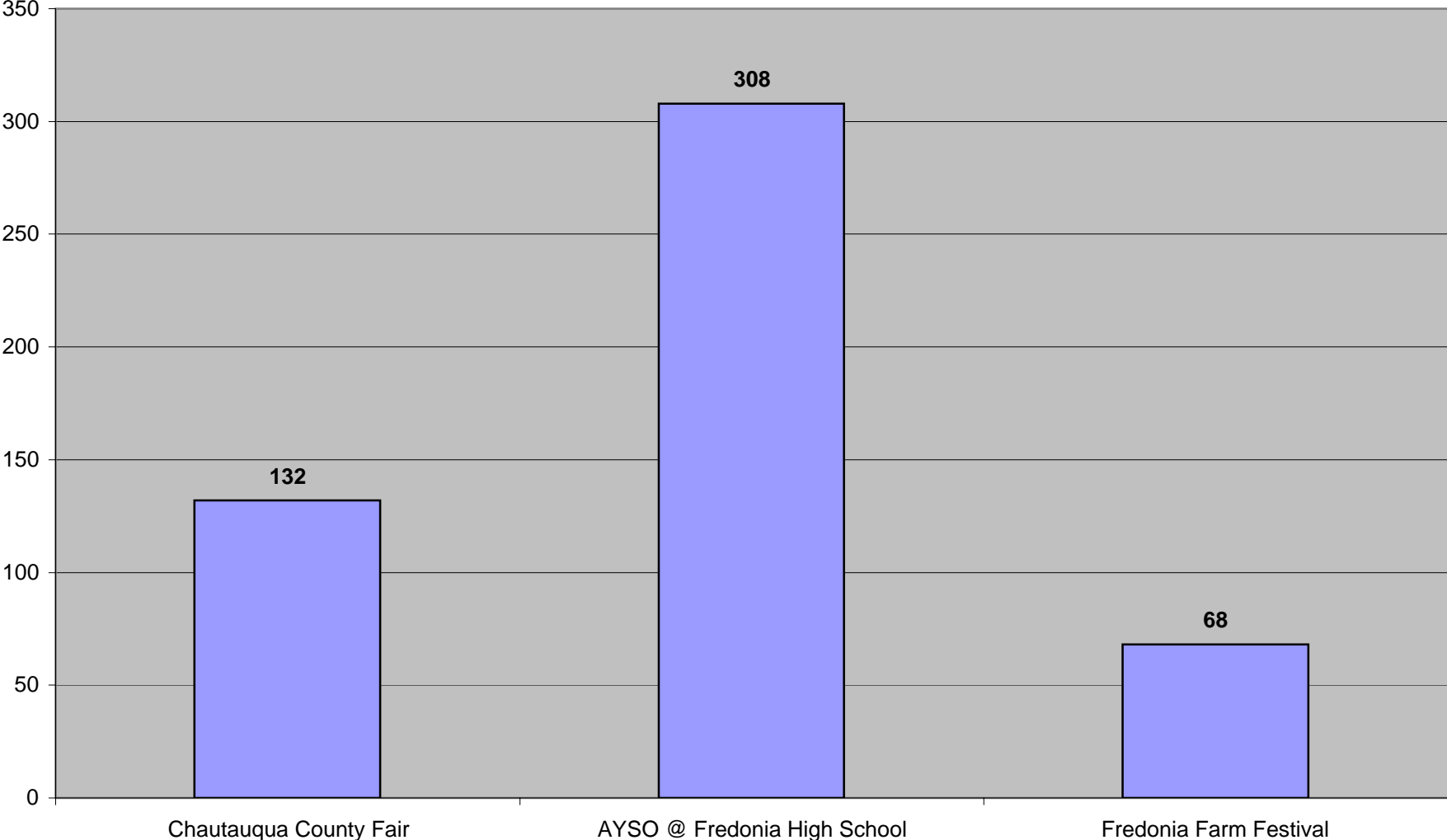

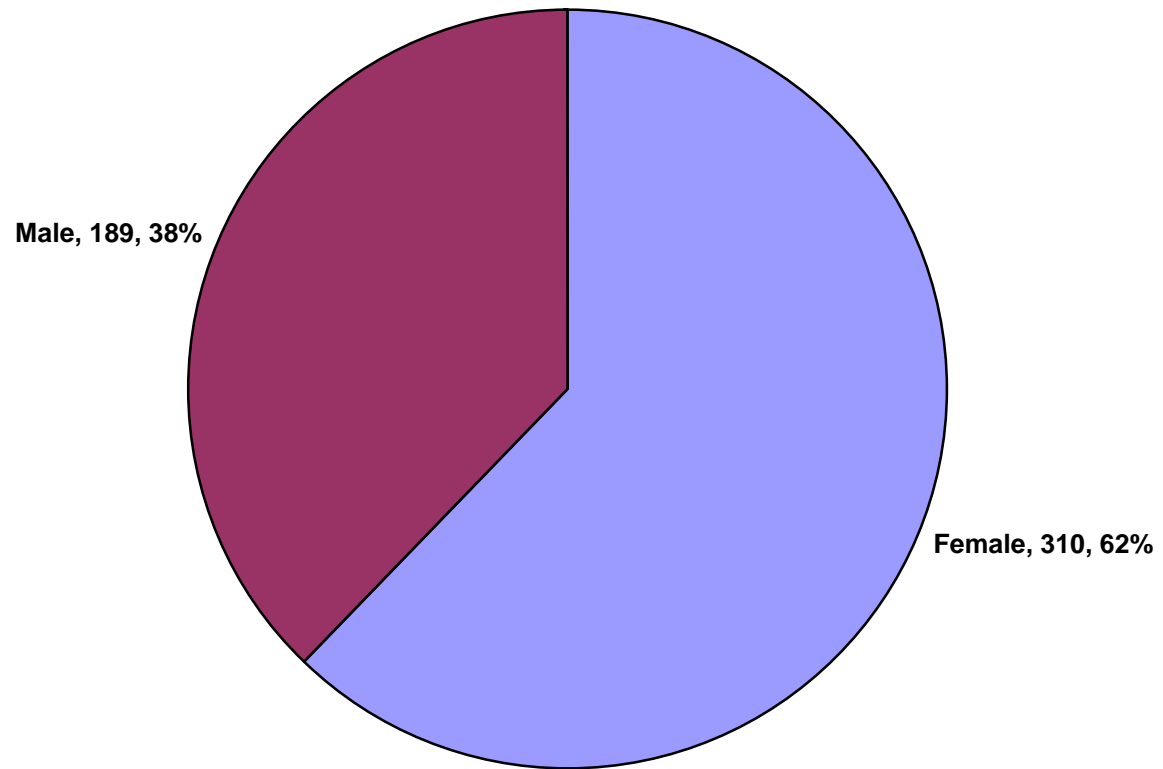

## I. Gender of Respondents

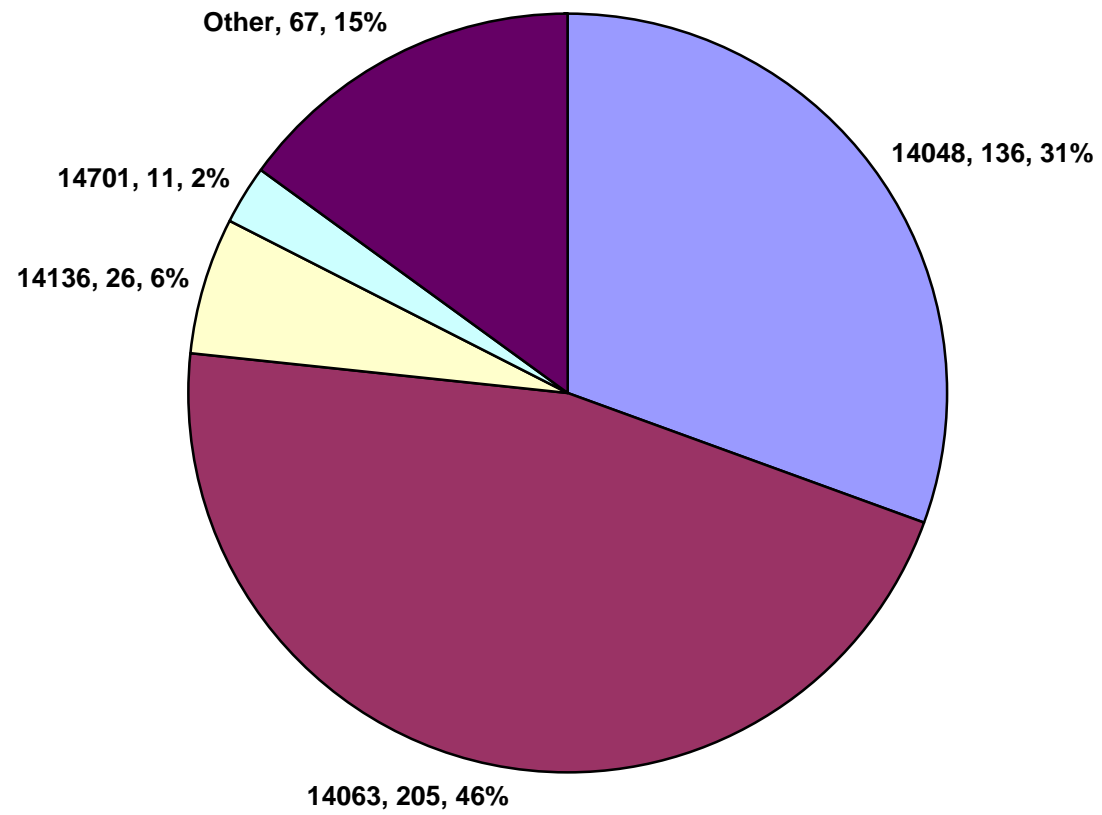

## I. Residential Zip Code

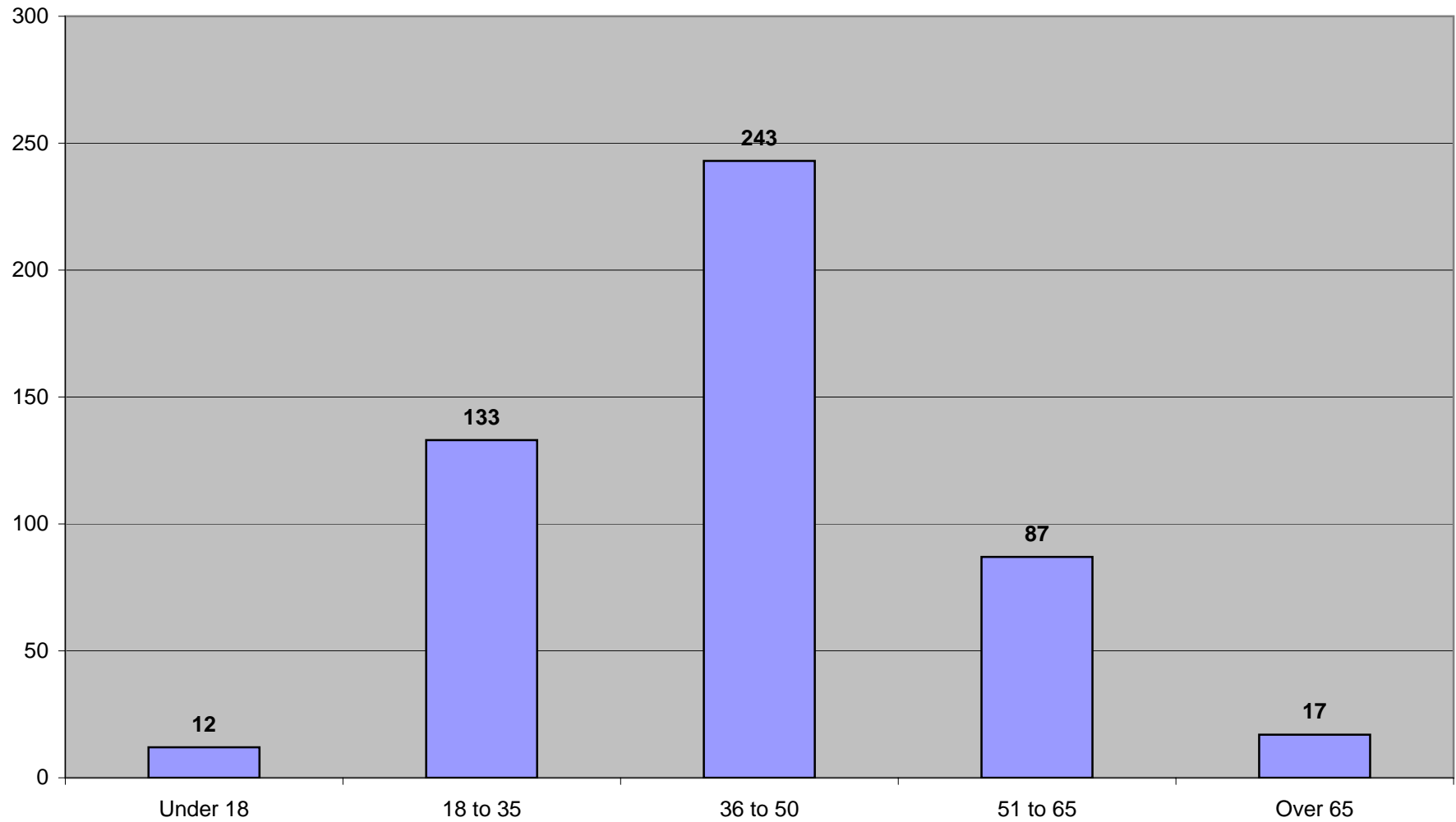

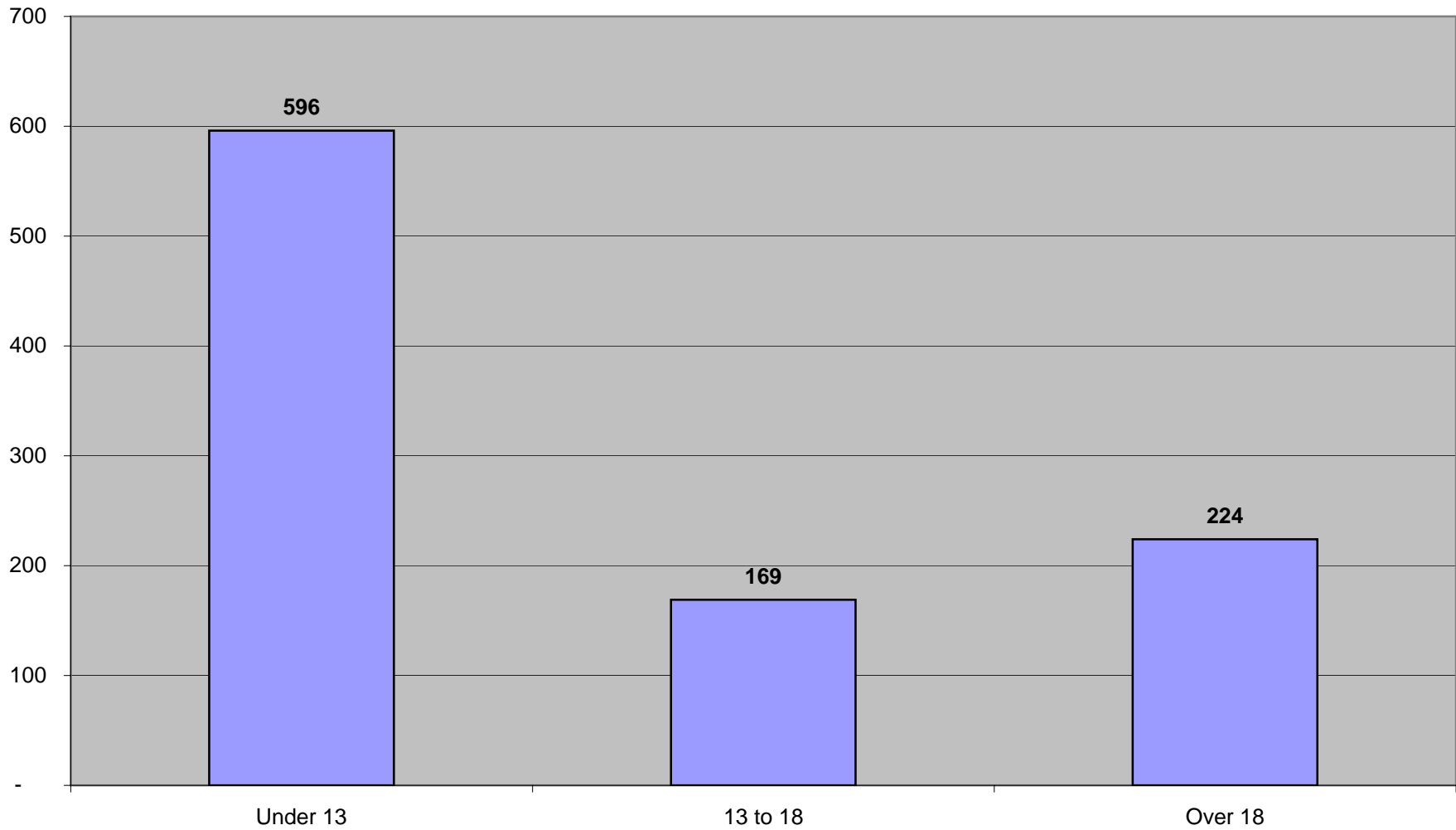

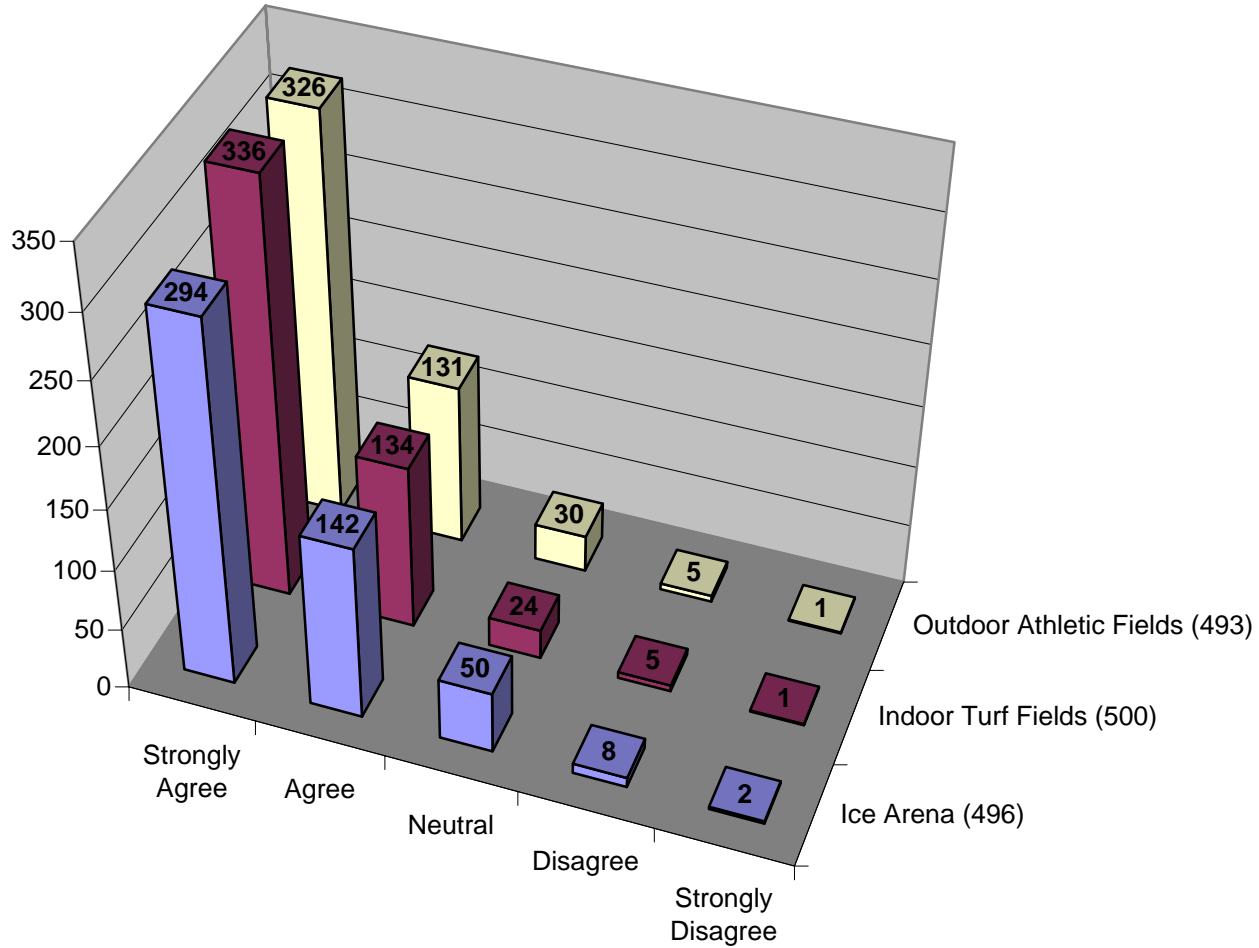

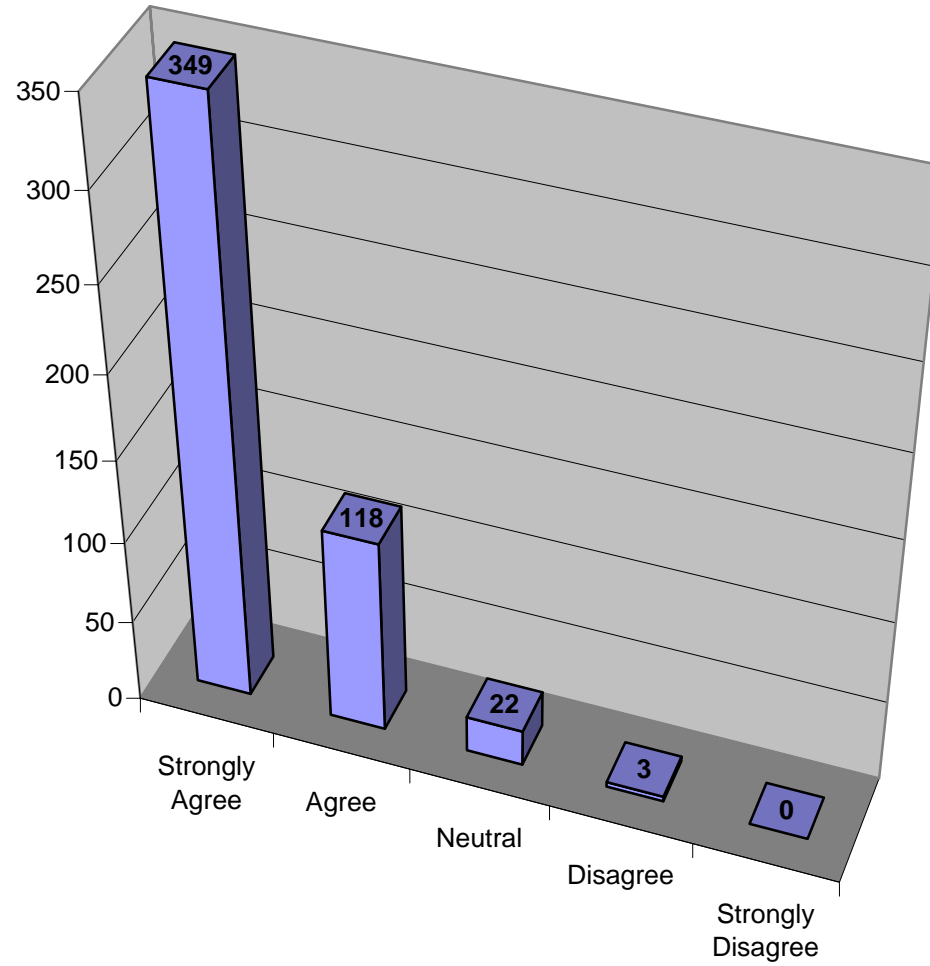

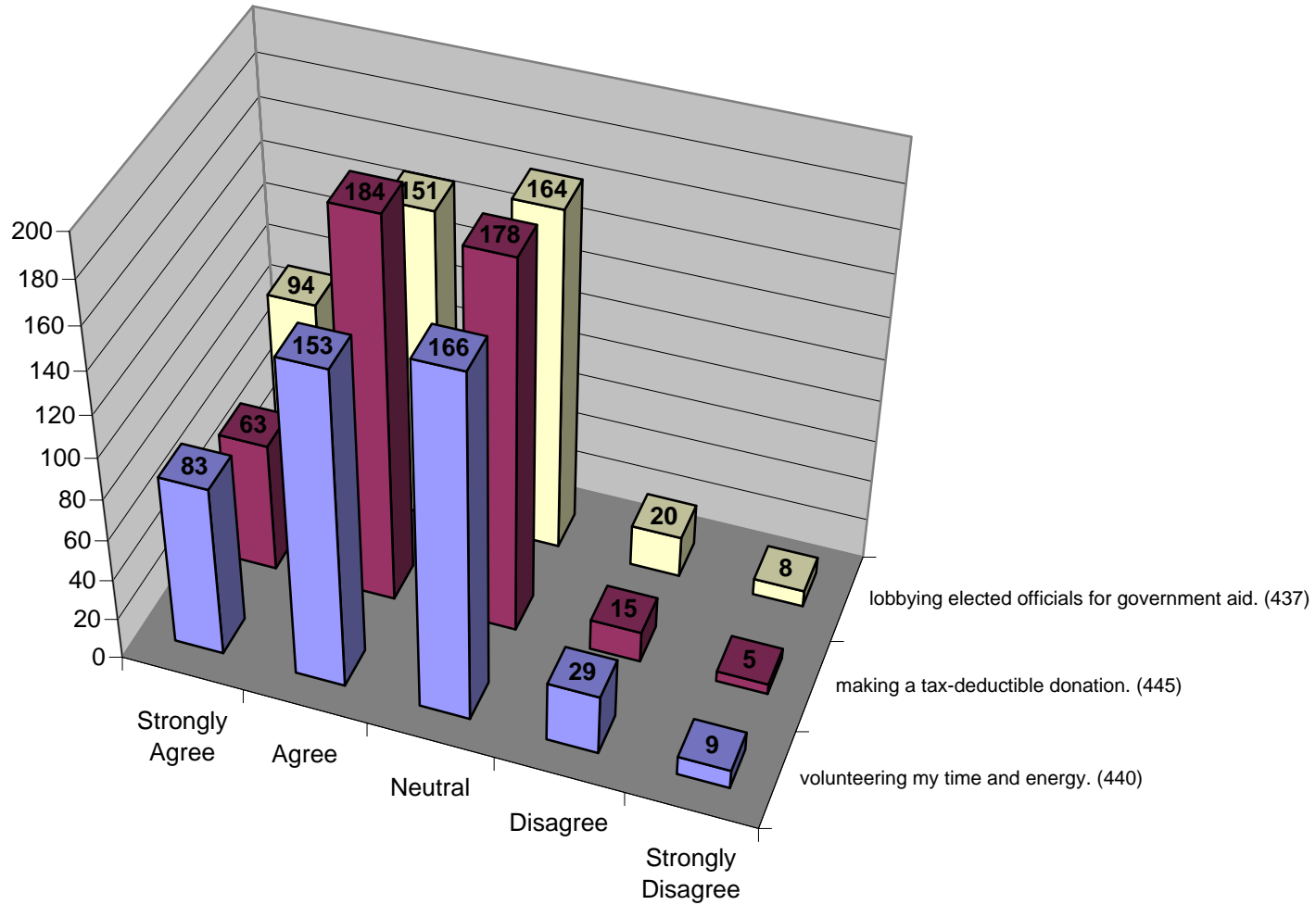
